#### The APCM and new PCC

- 1. The postponed Vestry and Annual Parochial Church Meetings were held on Monday 21 September when an amendment allowed Ian Nimmo Smith to stand again to ensure stability and continuity and Maggie Fernie was also elected as churchwarden. Deborah Bick was thanked for the spirit in which she carried out her duties as she stepped down.
- 2. The first PCC meeting was held on Tuesday 22 September when the officers were elected: Vice chair: Ian Nimmo-Smith (Nick is Chair), Patricia Abrey as PCC secretary (following Peter Hilken standing down but remaining on PCC) and Treasurer Michael Grande as before.
- 3. At its first meeting of 22 September our newly elected PCC met to consider, amend and approve the current risk assessments concerning COVID-19. The latest changes include the provision of music in church and the recent changes in government guidance permitting small choirs to sing. We also agreed the importance of communicating such substantial changes to the congregation so that everyone is clear what we are doing and why.
